Riverside Grad To Become Superintendent of the Mequon-Thiensville School System

Dr. Demond Means, a 1990 graduate of Riverside University high School and a member of the Foundation's Board of Directors, has recently been appointed Superintendent of the Mequon-Thiensville School District in north suburban Milwaukee. Dr. Means exemplifies the high academic standards and leadership qualities that Riverside stands for.

Following his graduation from Riverside, Dr. Means attended Concordia University where he received his Bachelor's Degree in secondary education in 1994. He wanted to start his teaching career in the Milwaukee Public Schools but at that time there was an abundance of Social Studies teachers available and all MPS could offer him was employment as a substitute teacher. So he began his professional journey as a Social Studies teacher at Homestead High School in the **Mequon-Thiensville School District** from 1994 until 1997 at which time he became an Assistant



Principal at Nicolet High School. He served in that capacity until 2000 when he became Principal of the **Maple Dale Middle School** for two years. He was hired as the Director of Human Resources in the **Wauwatosa School District** in 2002 and was promoted to CO-Interim Superintendent in 2004. Two years ago he moved to the **Mequon-Thiensville School**

District where he is currently working as the Director of Human Resources. The Mequon-Thiensville School Board recently hired Dr. Means to serve as the District's next Superintendent of Schools beginning in June, 2008 when the current Superintendent is scheduled to retire. While serving in these various educational capacities Dr. Means also managed to find time to obtain his Doctorate Degree in Education from Cardinal Stritch University in 2005.

Congratulations to Dr. Means for his achievements in the field of public education so far. He prepared well for this career, while attending Riverside University High School. His dedication and perseverance will continue to serve as an example to today's Riverside students.

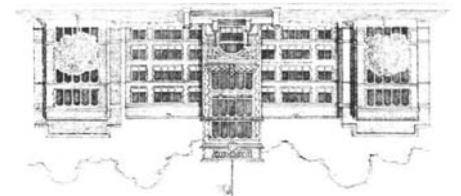
